## Rules of Business for Hybrid On-Site and On-Line Meetings for the AANR-NW Region

“Where there is radical difference of opinion in an organization, one side must yield. The great lesson for democracies to learn is for the majority to give the minority a full, free opportunity to present their side of the case, and then for the minority, having failed to win a majority to their views, gracefully to submit and to recognize the action as that of the entire organization, and cheerfully to assist in carrying it out, until they can secure its repeal.”

Henry Robert, *Parliamentary Law*

The business meeting will be recorded. This meeting is being run as a hybrid meeting, with some members at a meeting site and others by video conference. These rules are slightly modified to accommodate this format.

### MOTION PROCEDURES:

Motions are to be written and e-mailed or presented on-site to the president and to the secretary, and the secretary will transcribe the e-mailed motions to an AANR-NW Motion Form. One person needs to make the motion and one needs to second unless put forth by a committee. Whenever possible, the motion will be shown to the on-line board members via camera, scan or program.

When a motion is up for discussion:

- Speakers are limited to three minutes per speech.
- In the debate, each member has the right to speak only twice on the same question.
- Members cannot make a second speech so long as any member who has not spoken on the question desires the floor.
- Speakers shall be recognized to speak alternately for or against a pending motion.
- When speaking to a motion, the member should indicate whether he speaks in favor of the motion or in opposition.
- The presiding officer cannot cut off the debate as long as one member wishes to rise and speak.
- Any member can “move the previous question” which immediately stops debate. The motion needs a second, is not debatable and requires a 2/3rds vote to adopt.

## AANR NW Spring Board 2026

Creating a short video highlighting what AANR does, has been a pleasure. Jeff B. has graciously put it up on the AANR website and some clubs have put it on their individual websites as well. My hope is that the video will be played in offices that have the technology to do so. Playing on a loop while guests are checking in will possibly elicit interest in joining AANR. Most of our NW clubs do not have a screen in their offices, so I created an old school flip-book, with the information on the video, to put in your office and/or hang on a club bulletin board. Our guests are a great resource to gain members since they are already interested in being nude.

Jeff Baldassare was asked to host the Northwest Social Media sites which he started in May of last year. He had to create a new Instagram page for us as I wasn't able to get him on our existing account. Jeff has been doing a fantastic job on our social media sites and growth is up. In particular growth on X is up by over 2,000 followers since he took over earlier this year

### Treasurer Report Spring 2026 Board Meeting

The 2025 Annual Audit will take place on Friday April 10<sup>th</sup> in the Lodge at Serenity Mountain Retreat at 5pm. If you would like to help participate, please text me at 206-406-8035. We need 4 people. It really is fun and not hard to do. I can train you and I'll be there to answer any questions you may have.

We have a credit card for the AANR-NW Region Board expenditures. We need to create a procedure on how recurring charges can be accounted for and tracked.

Attached are the reports from 2025. We had a net gain of \$472.85. Most committees and officers stayed under budget however we were under funded by our hopes of about \$4,300. We have over \$60,000 in our legal fund. Over \$30,000 in our savings. Thank you all for being conscientious of our little budget.

We need to keep promoting signing up for AANR either from the club level or regionally. We hope to figure out a way during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Alvord Nude in the Northwest Campout. I will be bringing my Starlink mobile and computer to get people to sign up. We also need to have more clubs in the Northwest be 100%! They get advertising and legislative advocacy.

Checking Balance as of March 13, 2026 - \$7,292.74 but I have not reimbursed Andee and Jenny for the AANR Mid-Winter meeting and have not paid the usual yearly fees to the AANR Education Foundation, American Nudist Research Library, Willies Library Site Support, NW Association of Washington Membership, or SOLV membership fee. They will be paid after the spring board meeting.

# 2026 AANR-NW SPRING BOARD MEETING

## Legislation Committee Report

AANR is preparing to make a change in eliminating the Student Membership designation in its bylaws during the AANR election this spring. AANR-NW currently has an exemption from regional dues for Student members in its own bylaws.

### **This is the part of the AANR Bylaws to be affected:**

*Article VI Regional Divisions  
Section D Memberships*

#### *2 Voting Members*

- b) Young Adult Membership is offered at a reduced rate to individuals who are between the ages of 18 and 28 and who provide evidence of age.*
- c) Student Membership is offered at a reduced rate to individuals who are between the ages of 18 and 25 and who provide evidence of enrollment in a postsecondary institution of learning.*

### **Here is the AANR plan for the change:**

Action:

- 1. To proceed with a Bylaws modification motion to eliminate the Young Adult Member Category (ages 18-28) in preparation for a new Young Nudist Category (ages 18-29)*

*Vote: 2026 · Implementation: January 1, 2027*

- 2. To proceed with a Bylaws modification motion to eliminate the Student Member Category (ages 18-25) in preparation for a New Young Nudist Membership Category (ages 18-29).*

*Vote: 2026 · Implementation: January 1, 2027*

### **This is the part of our Bylaws that would be out of sync if the proposal passes:**

*Article IV Membership*

*A 2 Annual AANR Northwest dues will be waived for AANR Student Memberships.*

We should discuss this and come up with alternatives if the Proposition passes. We could: eliminate the affected section altogether; change "Student" to "Young Nudist"; or possibly put in a partial waiver for those in the amended membership category and age bracket; or take some other action.

The Legislation committee will present this to the Spring Board meeting for a discussion point with the recommendation from the board meeting being submitted to the delegates at the convention in the proper (45 day) time frame. The AANR election should be concluded prior to our convention and, if the AANR proposal fails, we can withdraw any regional proposal we come forward with.
