AANR-NW Bylaws

ARTICLE XVI

Amendments: Proposed bylaw amendments shall be submitted to the member clubs 45 days prior to the general assembly meeting. Amendments to these bylaws shall become effective upon approval by 3/4 of the delegates voting at the general assembly meeting. [Major changes to the regional Articles of Incorporation shall be made in the same manner. Address update to the Articles of Incorporation may be made by 2/3 vote of the regional board of directors.]

Purpose: The bylaws define how they may be updated, but don't specify a procedure for updating the articles of incorporation. We have used the bylaw procedure in the past and this change makes that official, and simplifies a change of address.

There was discussion during motion #5 on the meaning of the word "major". Mike Parker stated that if we made a change that changed the intention of who we are or what we do, that would be a major change. There was no further discussion.

Nude in the Northwest Jenny Agee

The Nude in the Northwest Alvord Desert campout came about as a way to advertise AANR outside of our normal means. Previously we used the Portland World Naked Bike Ride, but that was no longer possible. Secondary to advertising, was to give our AANR/NW Direct Members another benefit. As it turned out, there was a third benefit that was having members of our various NW clubs work together to organize and host such an outing. The first campout was a tremendous success. Sadly, the second had to be canceled at the last minute due to weather conditions at the playa. If anyone has a suggestion for a backup or alternate location that would suit this campout, please let us know. Our private Facebook group is Nude in the Northwest.

Andee opened the floor to anyone to express what they would like to see from the AANR/NW board.

Gypsie Gitane spoke about her desire to reduce the amount of physical paperwork in our offices and is searching for ways to make record keeping more of an electronic format.

Mike McCormick asked about ways to help the clubs delegates know what they would be voting on ahead of time. Tom Rodgers answered that the club's AANR director reports back to the club on current events and that this person would be a useful source of information. Jim Lahey stated that previous meeting minutes and reports are available on the AANR/NW website.

Eric Thompson is the Kaniksu Ranch PR contact. He would like to get a collaboration going with PR contacts from other clubs to trade ideas and best practices. One idea would be to use Discord for a chat group.

Rules of Business for Hybrid On-Site and On-Line Meetings for the AANR-NW Region

The business meeting will be recorded. This meeting is being run as a hybrid meeting, with some members at a meeting site and others by video conference. These rules are slightly modified to accommodate this format.

MOTION PROCEDURES:

Motions are to be written and e-mailed or presented on-site to the president and to the secretary, and the secretary will transcribe the e-mailed motions to an AANR-NW Motion Form. One person needs to make the motion and one needs to second unless put forth by a committee. Whenever possible, the motion will be shown to the on-line board members via camera, scan or program.

When a motion is up for discussion:

- Speakers are limited to three minutes per speech.
- In the debate, each member has the right to speak only twice on the same question.
- Members cannot make a second speech so long as any member who has not spoken on the question desires the floor.
- Speakers shall be recognized to speak alternately for or against a pending motion.
- When speaking to a motion, the member should indicate whether he speaks in favor of the motion or in opposition.
- The presiding officer cannot cut off the debate as long as one member wishes to rise and speak.
- Any member can “move the previous question” which immediately stops debate. The motion needs a second, is not debatable and requires a 2/3rds vote to adopt.

The Consortium of the four nudist libraries, which the northwest library is a founding member of, has lost the one affiliated with the Naturist Society as it is planning to close, with plans for transfer of materials still up in the air.
